RE: School Council

Dear Parents and Carers,

At Christchurch Infant school, we believe that it is important for all children to understand 'My Voice Matters'. To support this, we have a school council who listen to the ideas of the children and feed this back to the headteacher, helping to share what is important to them. Last year, the school council helped to decide which local charity they would like to support as well as helping to promote key messages in the school and to be a role model to others. School Council members meet regularly to discuss what we can do to work together and help our school community to be the best that it can be and then share this with our class.

Each class has 2 school council members who are voted for by their class. To be voted for, the children in Year 1 and 2 are asked to do a short talk of why they think they should be the school council members for their class. Your child has expressed an interest in being a school council member. If your child wishes to be considered for the School Council, a suggested support sheet can be collected from their class teacher. This can help them to write a few ideas so that they are ready to share with the rest of the class. Presentations will take place week beginning 28th September. Your class teacher will let their class know when they will vote for their 2 school council members. Children do not have to be in the school council, your child has indicated at school that they would like to present and to be considered. This is not home learning.

Please be aware that only 2 children from each class will become the school council member.
